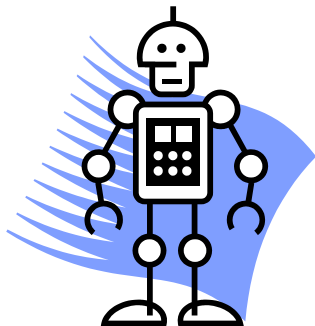
The wicked witch cast a dark evil curse upon several innocent villagers.
