MOVE TO LEARN

We are now a **MOVE TO LEARN** school

Move to Learn is a simple movement program to help children acquire the skills they need in the way, and order, that they were originally intended to be acquired – through movement.

It is a sensory motor program, sequenced to follow the natural stages of human development experienced by children in their early years.

The program assists in integrating left and right brain functions and helps to mature the vestibular system. If a child is not well integrated, lacks body awareness or has immaturities with their proprioceptive or tactile systems, there can be a serious impact on the child's readiness, and therefore ability, to learn.

Most children benefit from the program with an increased concentration and ability to focus even if they are not experiencing difficulties with learning.
