## PUBLIC DENTAL SERVICES

The Murrumbidgee Local Health District has school dental clinics throughout our area, including Tumut and Wagga which provide **free** dental treatment for students up to the age of 18 years.

Recently, a new program has been established between NSW Health, the Murrumbidgee Local Health District and Charles Sturt University for students who have not yet received an appointment at their local clinic due to high demand. This program will see 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year CSU Bachelor of Oral Health students provide free dental treatment at the CSU Dental clinic in Wagga.

A brochure is attached will explains the program in more detail. Assistance may be available for families who have transport difficulties in getting to Wagga.
