As a special treat for our Kindergarten to Year 2 students, a special excursion has been planned for them to have a day out, visiting several local attractions later this term.

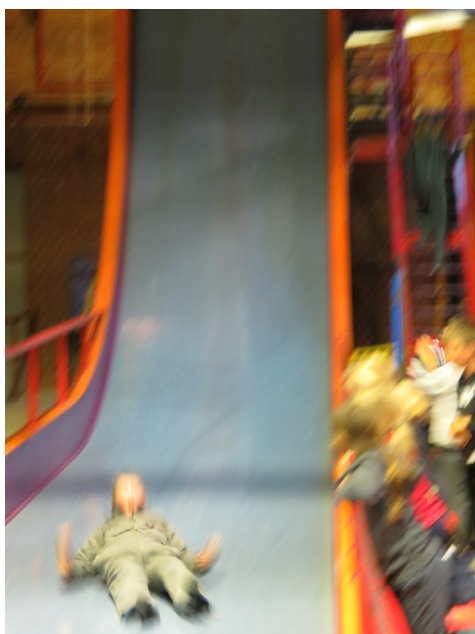
The itinerary has been confirmed and includes a visit to the Broom Factory, Library, Museum and a River Walk and picnic in the park.
