Cabramurra Sports Day

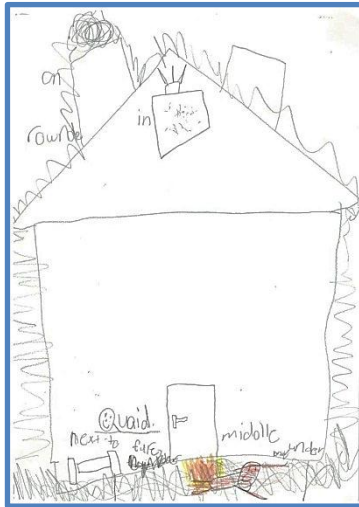
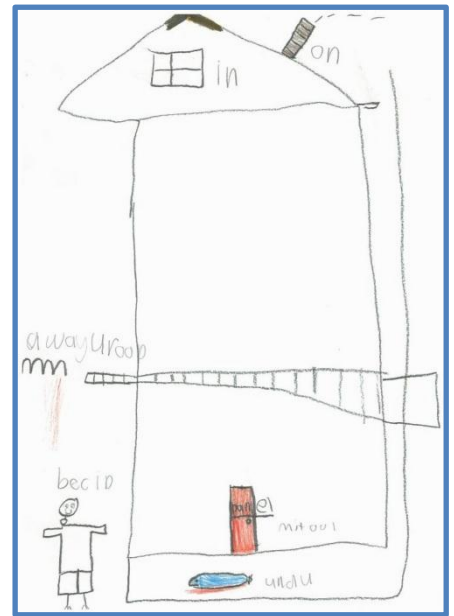
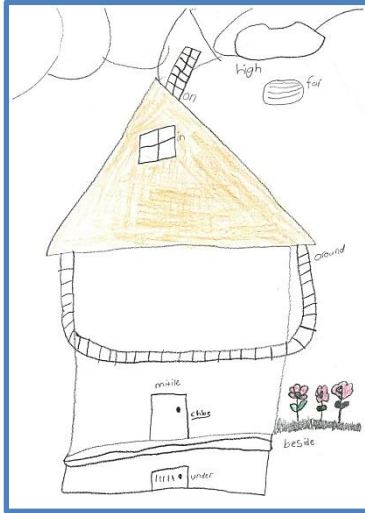
Our next visit to Cabramurra will be on Wednesday, 30th October. We will depart from school at 8.00am, returning by 4.00pm.
