Last week our Year 2-6 students travelled to the Montreal Theatre to see The Anzac Story! 100 Year Anniversary Show which was brought to Tumut by Sydney company, Iconic Productions.

The show told the story of Australia's involvement in World War 1 through the eyes of the central characters: a young recruit, an experienced company commander and a nurse.

Told with a mixture of narrative and drama, the show was at times humorous, a little scary and also sad as it taught us about life at the front what it was like for our serving soldiers.

Around 26 students had the opportunity to play small parts as soldiers, stretcher bearers and nurses. Josh and Teagan performed well in their roles as a soldier and a nurse, alongside their peers from the other participating schools. The cast commented on the mature manner in which these students approached the serious nature of their roles.

It was a great addition to our HSIE studies at school and particularly relevant to us as we commemorate the 100 year anniversary of the landing at Gallipoli this year.
