Mrs Dean's lessons on light

This term the students have been learning about light with Mrs Dean. In weeks 4 and 5, the students looked at opaque, transparent and translucent light. They made shadow puppets to show how to project images with light. In week 6, the students learnt about refraction which is when light can bend. They experimented this by putting a texta in water and using a magnifying glass from a far to flip the image in the magnifying glass. Students also learnt about prisms and how the light separates in rainbow colours such as kaleidoscopes.

Senior Sydney Excursion
