Skiing – Selwyn Snowfields

We will be starting our ski lessons next Tuesday at Selwyn Snowfields. In the permission note, the pickup time from school was 8:30am, however we will need to **move it to 8:00am**. Please ensure all clothing and other items are clearly labelled with your child's name. Students will need to bring a packed recess and lunch, and a water bottle to last them for the day. Students cannot purchase food from the resort café.

Payment for ski trips must be made before boarding the bus each week. The cost will be \$25 per student per trip.
