On Tuesday 25th July all of the ALPSS kids went to Selwyn snow fields.

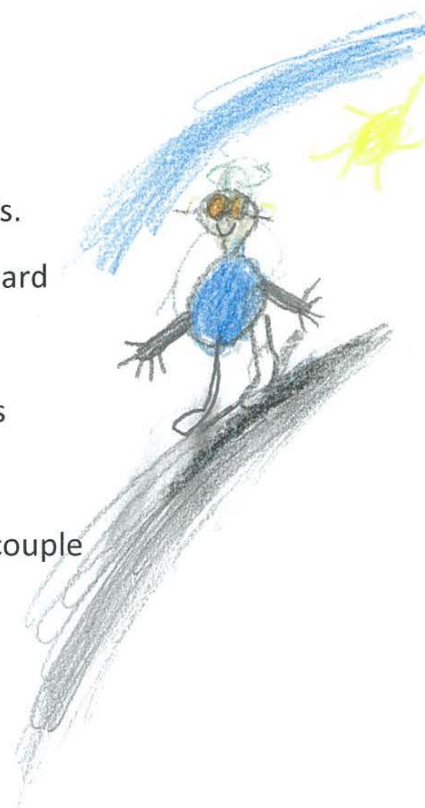
First we went to borrow some boots and skis. My boots were very hard to get on.
