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

## Home Learning

At Talbingo Public School students are not set formal homework, however there are a number of alternatives for parents if you wish to keep your child practicing essential skills at home.

1. Read with your child everyday. Older children should aim for at least 30 minutes each night.
2. Mangahigh is a mathematics website that all students have access to and tasks are set by Ms Nicholls to ensure they're appropriateness for each student.
3. Stepsweb is a spelling program, and Reading Eggs a literacy program that again students have full

access to in the home.

4. Also, keeping a diary helps students practice their writing, spelling and grammar.

Setting up a timetable for your child to access a different website each school afternoon (even for just 15 minutes!) along with reading practice would greatly benefit their learning.
