Home Learning

At Talbingo Public School students are not set formal homework, however there are a number of alternatives for parents if you wish to keep your child practicing essential skills at home.

- 1. Read with your child everyday. Older children should aim for at least 30 minutes each niaht.
- 2. Mangahigh is a mathematics website that all students have access to and tasks are set by Ms Nicholls to ensure they're appropriateness for each student.
- 3. Stepsweb is a spelling program, and Reading Eggs a literacy program that again students have full

access to in the home

4. Also, keeping a diary helps students practice their writing, spelling and grammar.

Setting up a timetable for your child to access a different website each school afternoon (even for just 15 minutes!) along with reading practice would greatly benefit their learning.
